MEMBERS' ANNUAL ART EXHIBITION 2015

The Malta Society of Arts (MSA) Members' Annual Art Exhibition 2015 is being held at Palazzo de La Salle, 219 Republic Street, Valletta, between 1 October and 24 October 2015.

Entries for this initiative are subject to the following terms and conditions.

Terms and Conditions

The exhibition is open to MSA members only.

One entry per person may be submitted.

Works may be executed in any medium.

Works may be in 2D or 3D, and can be in any hanging or free standing genres, such as drawing, paintings, sculpture, photography and other. There are no restrictions on the choice of subject and / or expression.

Works should be recent and not previously exhibited in any other event. The aim of this exhibition is to present a high standard of artworks.

Copies of other works will not be accepted; any work which is found to be a copy shall be removed and considered ineligible at any stage of the process.

All 2D works must be labelled in block letters: a) the full name; b) the title, c) the medium and d) the selling price; to be ready mounted and/or framed for hanging with D-rings and cord/wire. Clip frames are not accepted. Hanging works may not be larger than 100cm x 75 cm.

All 3D works must be labelled on their base in block letters: a) the full name; b) the title, c) the medium and d) the selling price in euros. 3D entrants shall provide their own stand and / or plinth.

Entrants must submit by post or by hand the completed and signed submission form with a submission fee of €15.

A digital image of good resolution (not less than 500Kb in JPEG or PDF format) is to be sent to msaexhibitions@gmail.com for printing and catalogue purposes. 3D entries must supply more than one image with views from at least three different angles. Alternative arrangements may be discussed for those entrants unable to send image/s via email.

Cheques payable to the Malta Society of Arts, Palazzo de La Salle, 219 Republic Street, Valletta, Malta, by not later than Friday 31 July, 2015. A receipt will be received by all entrants. A reimbursement will be effected for unexhibited works.

Late submissions will not be accepted.

Exhibited works need to be collected Monday, 26 October 2015 from 8.00 a.m. till 7.00 p.m.

Unless notified via e-mail by the entrant, MSA is unable to store uncollected entries.

Other

Display of exhibits shall be entirely at the discretion of MSA, whose decision shall be final and not subject to review.

All decisions taken by MSA are final and no correspondence can be entered into.

The MSA pledges to take care of the exhibits, but cannot in any circumstances accept responsibility for loss of, damage to or theft of any exhibits.

The MSA maintains the right to reproduce without compensation, or to allow the reproduction in any medium of publication, any of the entries exhibited with acknowledgement of the entrants.

Notwithstanding the generality of the forgoing provisions, it is agreed that Intellectual Property Rights in respect to the entry shall always pertain to the entrant.

The MSA will be working towards substantial media coverage for the best possible promotion.
