• **General Terms and Conditions**

MSA is offering courses in various subjects and fields of study. Information about each course is to be found on the prospectus or website: www.artsmalta.org. Applications are to be sent, either by post at Palazzo de La Salle, 219 Republic Street Valletta, or by hand at the same address, from Monday to Friday:

October - May 8:00 -15:00hrs

June – September - 8.00-12.00hrs

• **Registration Fees**

Registration Fees are indicated in the section concerning ‘further information’. Students who enrol are informed a week prior the commencement of course of any further details about courses. Applications are processed on a first come first served basis.

• **Calendar**

Courses commence during the first weeks of October and end towards the end of May. Courses are held over a period of one or two semesters: namely, October-January and February-May. Summer Courses are held between July-September. Further details regarding specific courses are to be found in the prospectus or on the website.

• **Certificate and Qualifications**

Courses offered by MSA aim to reach a high standard of excellence. Students who succeed in following the given syllabus and pass the final assessment will be awarded certificate.

• **Course Registration**

Courses will only be offered if a sufficient number of students are registered.

• **Additional Note:**

Once registration is accepted, applicants are to abide by the rules issued by MSA.
